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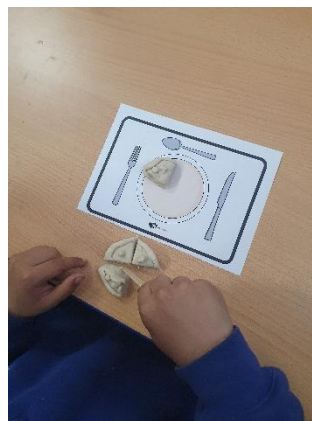
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fractions work while building their confidence in recognising and creating equal parts.

In Year 5, the children have finished their DT unit on Mechanisms. The children reflected on their projects and discussed what went well and what they would do differently.





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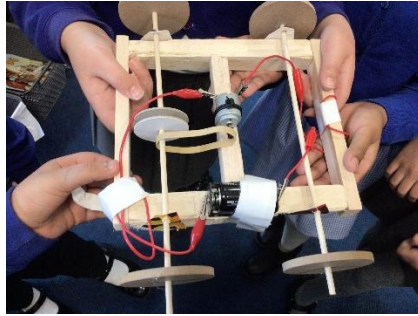

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Eldon uniform Expectation
