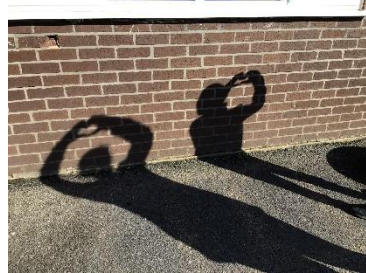

Year 3

In Year 3 we have been investigating how shadows are formed and discovered that objects need to be opaque to create a clear, strong shadow. As part of our learning, we carried out experiments using a range of opaque, translucent, and transparent materials, carefully observing how each one affected the shadow produced. The children thoroughly enjoyed predicting, testing, and discussing their findings, developing their scientific thinking, and understanding along the way.
